General Policies for Dance Company Use

- Outside alcohol is not permitted anywhere on the property. Any alcohol found will be removed immediately, and individuals may be asked to exit the venue.
- Crock pots, hot plates, and other food-heating devices are not allowed backstage or in dressing rooms due to safety and food quality concerns. If the event has coordinated with a pre-approved caterer through our team, backstage meals may be provided that way. Otherwise, teams are welcome to use restaurant delivery services or designate someone to bring in prepared meals from licensed food establishments backstage only. Participants may bring individual lunch bags, which will be permitted backstage.
- Coolers with lunches and water for performers may be kept backstage in your designated area. Please be mindful to keep belongings organized and out of pathways.
- For safety reasons, running is not allowed in any public areas, including lobbies, hallways, and stairwells near the backstage entrance.
- The second floor of the The Stranahan is closed to all dance company participants and guests.
- The service elevator may be used by staff or designated team leads to transport equipment safely to the basement level. Children may not use the elevator unless accompanied by an adult.
- Basement restrooms will remain closed during the event unless additional access is needed. Our team will monitor usage and open these restrooms as necessary.
- If your group has rented the Great Hall, it may be used for warm-ups and rehearsals. If the Great Hall is not part of your rental, practice space is limited to the basement dressing room areas.
- There are to be no “team tables” set in the lobby for snacks/food
- Children must be supervised at all times while in the building.
