



DANCE COMPETITION BACKSTAGE VENUE GUIDELINES

Your safety and security are most important to us. The following are the venue's guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation and have fun.

PERFORMER ENTRANCE

Performers must enter the building through the **Backlot Entrance**—**not** the Main Entrance. Entry will be denied at the Main Entrance for those carrying costume bags, clothing trunks, and bags larger than 12" x 6" x 12".

Access to venue is based on **a scheduled time set by the venue's client**. Early entry will not be permitted, even if requested by individual dance studios, teachers, or performers. Please plan to arrive according to your assigned time slot.

SECURITY INSPECTION

All entrants are subject to security screening upon arrival. This includes the use of **metal detectors** and **bag checks**. Please note that bringing bags may delay your entry, so plan accordingly.

TRAVEL LIGHT

Bring only the **essential items** needed for your performance. This helps speed up entry and keeps the backstage area clear and safe.

DRESSING ROOM POLICIES

For **fire safety** and to comply with **emergency exit regulations**, performers must use **designated dressing rooms only**. Changing in hallways or blocking doorways is strictly prohibited. Please be aware that Live Nation crew and personnel **are permitted to walk through backstage hallways** as part of their job duties. To maintain privacy and professionalism, all changing must take place **inside dressing rooms only**.

Items are PERMITTED through Backstage entrance and must remain in dressing room areas only:

Bags/ backpacks, clothing trunks, plastic or metal beverage containers (*must remain in backstage/ dressing room areas*), snacks, individual meals (*no catering/ food platters/ ice chests*), costumes/ makeup, and hair dressing tools.

Items NOT PERMITTED include, but are not limited to:

Glass containers, aluminum cans, ice chests/ coolers, tables, chairs or stools, helium balloons, candles, laser pointers, professional audio/video recording equipment, camera tripods, selfie sticks, noise makers/ horns, megaphones, weapons of any kind, alcohol, illegal drugs/substances, marijuana, animals (*except service animals*), fireworks/ fire starters, and any items deemed dangerous by the venue GM or Supervisor.
